Financial – In-patient days totaled 177 for January. Patient mix was 19% in-patient, 62% Skilled and 19% Intermediate Swing Bed. Year-To-Date In-patient days are 173% of budget and 179% of last year's volume. YTD Swing bed days are 87% of budget and are 86% of last year. YTD ER visits are 116% of budget and 119% of the prior year. YTD PT visits are 106% of budget and 122% of last year. YTD OT visits were 121% of budget and 122% of last year. Operating Income was a loss of \$1,193,599 for the month and a loss of \$276,009 for the year. Depreciation expense year to date was \$877,890. Net Income was negative for January \$978,321. YTD was also positive, \$1,403,009. Accounts Receivable decreased from last month, \$121,247. However, A/R is higher than this time last year by \$1,466,773. This month we experienced an increase cash flow of \$583,418. Acute and Swing Bed days 177. Days in A/R slight increase from prior month to 74.95. During the month, 4,260 scripts filled. Decrease of 198 from last month. Operating Revenue decreased this month compared to the prior month's total. Retail Pharmacy revenue was \$365,705 for the month and budgeted for \$315,000 this month. Operating Income for the month was a gain of \$47,561 and YTD income was a loss of \$39,376.

Emergency Department wait times faster and our times are comparing to those across the state. Weston County's vaccination rates are 37%, 78% for the facility and 44% for Wyoming. WCHS currently has 7 temp staff.
